It's not a formal reporting procedure. No action will be taken.



Speak with your Tutor, College Discrimination & Harassment Contact or someone you trust in your College about your experience. When wanted you can ask about the formal procedures and how to initiate these.

Harassment & Sexual Misconduct procedure, Complaints procedure or Discipline procedure
